Maintaining Farmland Leases: Managing Conflict in Your Lease Agreement

The State Agriculture Development Committee (SADC) and the Northeast Organic Farming Association of New Jersey (NOFA-NJ) will offer an educational workshop for farmers and landowners on preventing and managing conflicts in farm leases, on March 29th at the Rutgers EcoComplex in Bordentown.
